College Council FY 23 Goals: Consensus was reached on adopting the following goals for FY 23.

- Council will provide feedback on the implementation of diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) initiatives.

Career Cube: Information and a demonstration video was presented about Career Cube, a new tool being used in Career Services. Career Cube takes photos and allows users to create a social media presence at a professional level. It will be utilized in various class projects and use of the tool is free to all students, staff, and community members.

A Culture of Guided Pathways: A student-centered approach utilizing tutors in Academic Success to keep students on their path was presented. Tutoring assistance is provided to students by meeting them “where they are,” including during onboarding, the virtual navigator program, embedded support during class, pop-up tutoring in hallways, and virtual tutoring for students at home or in their workplace.
