

Operational Assembly: Hilary Meyer provided these highlights from the August Operational Assembly. The Title V Grant, which has produced some great outcomes for students, ends on September 30. Career Services will hold a Career Fair on October 4. HR reported that in 2024, Hourly employees will be able to earn paid time off. IT is exploring a change to the college's wireless environment for greater security. Triton is in partnership with ReUp Education to increase enrollment through contact with students who haven't completed their degree or certificate. Events are being finalized for Hispanic Heritage Month, and the Illinois Community College Diversity Commission professional development series is launching next month. Research reported that Fall 10th Day is September 6.

Student Success: Jason Lemberg presented information on the use of CRM Advise by faculty and support staff and how alerts are responded to. CRM Advise is: 1) a responsive student tracking system aligned with interventions and resources to help students stay on the pathway, persist, progress, and complete; 2) a student database with potential for specified tracking and outreach capabilities; and 3) a data-management system with event tracking, student success measurements, and real-time student support. The potential of CRM Advise, with full-picture tracking of a student's journey through Triton, allows for better support to students and increased retention.

College Council FY 24 Goals: Council set the following goals for FY 24:

- *Council will engage in the campus-wide preparation for the HLC Reaffirmation of Accreditation visit.*
- *Council will provide feedback on the progress of Strategic Plan goals.*
- *Council will provide feedback on improving the student experience on campus.*

Communication, Participation, Accreditation: HLC representatives will be on campus February 5-6, 2024 for the Reaffirmation of Accreditation visit. Preparation for the visit is taking place this fall through department and committee meetings, the Center for Teaching Excellence and Professional Development Center, and other venues.
