

# **DMS** Application Process



## **Program Requirements:**

- Graduate of an accredited program in Diagnostic Medical Sonography
- ☐ Currently registered by the American Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonographers (ARDMS) and holds the Registered Diagnostic Medical Sonographer credential (RDMS)
- Must have successfully passed the Sonography Principles and Instrumentation examination (SPI) for current admission
- Students must place in college level reading, writing and math by coursework or placement scores at Triton College





# **DMS** Application Process

## **Application Process:**

- I. Attend a Vascular Information Session
- II. Complete the Triton College Application: <u>Triton</u> College Application
- III. Complete the Health Careers Application for Vascular Technology in Sonography: <u>Health Careers Application</u>
- IV. Send Transcripts (High School & College)
- v. Take placement exam, if warranted
- VI. Provide selective admission documentation:
  - A. Proof of successful completion of the SPI examination
  - B. Copy of ARDMS card
  - C. Employment verification letter on letterhead from employer when warranted
- VII. Application Admissions Committee Review

# **DMS Application Process**

### **Frequently Asked Questions:**

- What is the program commitment:
  - 2-semester, fast-paced program
  - Fall semester is packed with material and content and requires a considerable time commitment and study time for success
  - Spring requires less time on campus but does require 150 clinical hours to be completed\*
- When are classes offered: Online lecture and labs in the evenings/Saturday
- ☐ Is the ARDMS RVT board required for program completion: No
- What are the application deadlines:
  - March 15th
  - June 15th (for current DMS students ONLY)
- \* PLA (Prior Learning Assessment) clinical hours can be obtained via employer on the job training, if vascular in nature.
- Signed verification of vascular clinical hours needs to be sent via email from your employer (Radiologist or Lead Tech).







# Vascular Information Session

### Vascular Requirements:

After transcripts evaluation and verification, your application will move forward to the selective admission process. At this time, you will need to provide documentation that you currently hold the RDMS credential and have taken the SPI examination. Once all documentation has been received, your application will be put into the pool of eligible applicants. Eligible applicants will be considered on a point scale. This scale will be as follows.

More than one specialty credential: +1pt

**Triton DMS Alumni: +1pt** 

Additional Point Criteria requiring further documentation:

Currently Working as a Diagnostic Medical Sonographer for 1-5yrs\*: +1pt

Currently Working as a Diagnostic Medical Sonographer for 6 or more yrs.\*: +2pts

**Currently performing vascular examinations\*:** +1pt

ARDMS & RDMS card (Y/N)

**Proof of SPI exam (Y/N)** 

<sup>\*</sup>Employment verification letters will need to be submitted from the applicant explaining current position and duties performed to receive this credit. This documentation is to be sent on employer letterhead directly via email to christophacox@triton.edu.





# Vascular Information Session

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- 2. Currently registered by the American Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonographers (ARDMS) and hold the Registered Diagnostic Medical Sonographer credential (RDMS).
- 3. Successfully passed the Sonography Principles and Instrumentation examination (SPI) for current admission.

### **Steps for Applying:**

Complete Triton College application
Complete the Selective Admission application for Health Careers
Completion of placement testing or waiver
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- \_\_\_\_\_ Forward all official transcripts to Triton College Records Department
- \_\_\_\_\_ Provide selective admission documentation
- Proof of successful completion of the SPI examination
- Copy of ARDMS card
- Employment verification letter on letterhead from employer when warranted





# Vascular Information Session

## What does the program cost?

- ☐ Tuition per credit hour
- For example:
  - In-district \$265/credit hour \* 16 hours = \$4,240
  - Out-of-district \$478/credit hour \* 16 hours = \$7,648
  - Out-of-state \$563/credit hour \* 16 hours = \$9,008
