The tournament schedule is as follows:

- Women's Semifinals: Wednesday, March 5, at 5 p.m. and 7 p.m.
- Men's Semifinals: Thursday, March 6, at 5 p.m. and 7 p.m.
- Championship Games: Saturday, March 8--Women's Championship game at 5 p.m., Men's Championship at 7:30 p.m.

General admission is \$5 and children under 12 enter for free. Alcohol is not permitted on Triton's campus.

The Triton men's basketball team is 23-3 and ranked No. 4 in the latest NJCAA poll. The Trojans look to win their fourth regional crown in the last five seasons.
