"Once a customer trusts me to put in a new HVAC system, I will not let them down," he explained.

Today, Al Air, Inc. has grown into one of the top "Factory Authorized Dealer" in the area, recognized for its large volumes of sales and repairs in the Norridge/Harwood Heights communities.

"Since attending Triton College, my company has grown 10-15 percent per year," he said. "I have 10 employees and I'm well known throughout the community thanks to referrals from my current customers."

Lechowski said it's truly "an honor" to be selected for Triton's Wall of Fame, noting that his education at Triton played a key role in his successful and taught him valuable business life lessons.

"As a Wall of Fame inductee, I'm honored and feel like I'm making a difference in my community," said Lechowski.
